ALERT	DESCRIPTION	HOW TO ACCESS

Nixle	Text messages to cell phones for emergencies within your current location.	Registration required. Visit MendoReady.org to sign up.
Mendo Alert	Notification of emergencies via text, reverse 911 and email.	Registration required. Visit MendoReady.org to sign up.
Social Media	Posts regarding current events.	Visit www.MendoReady.org & County Facebook or X pages.
Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA)	Emergency alert to cell phones for emergencies within your current location.	No registration required. Alert is issued by the County.
Emergency Alert System (EAS)	Alerts radio listeners, TV viewers and those with NOAA Weather Radios.	No registration required. Alert is issued by County.
Tsunami Sirens (Coastal Only)	Alerts of possible tsunami threat.	Coastal sirens sound alerting need to evacuate.
Hi Lo Siren	Alerts neighborhoods of an Evacuation Order using two-tone siren.	Sheriff sounds Hi-Lo siren as they patrol neighborhoods during emergencies.
